

Step 6.

Fill the cartridge very S-l-o-w-l-y with the appropriate ink. The ink has to have time to run into the various internal chambers. Air and ink bubbles will come out of this hole. This is normal, be careful not to over full.

Step 7.

Seal the refill port hole with hot melt glue or tape.
